Dr. S Radhakrishnan , a legendary teacher and India 's second President is remembered on this day. He was also an accomplished scholar, a distinguished philosopher, a consummate statesman and an effective diplomat.

Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was born on 5<sup>th</sup> September 1888 in Tiruttani , Tamil Nadu. Radhakrishnan grew up to become an exemplary teacher who always strove to bring the best out of his students.

When Radhakrishnan become the second President of India, some of his fans and students met him to request his permission to commemorate his birthday with a celebration. He replied by saying

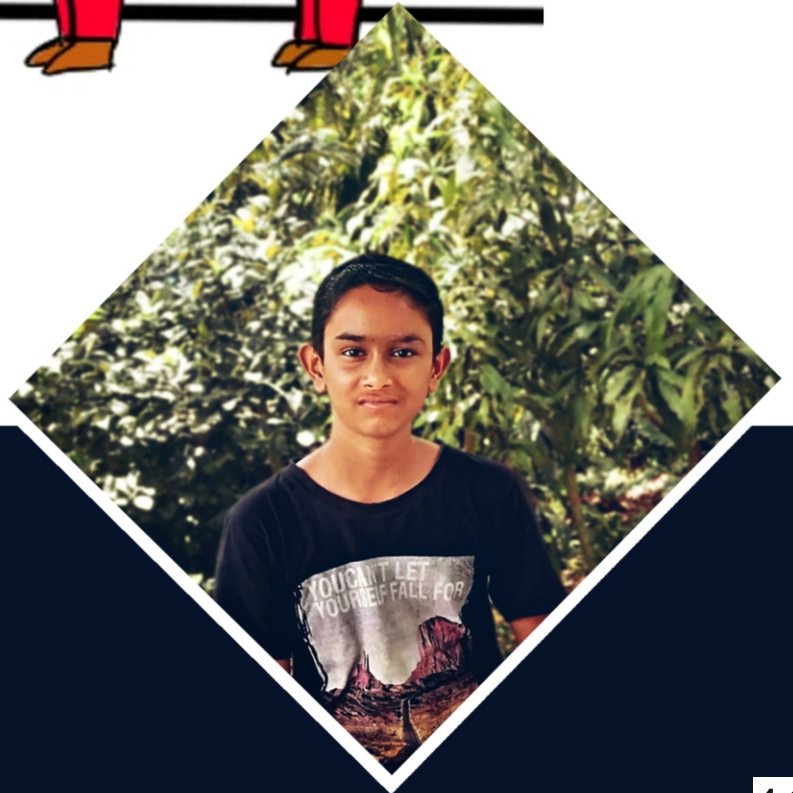
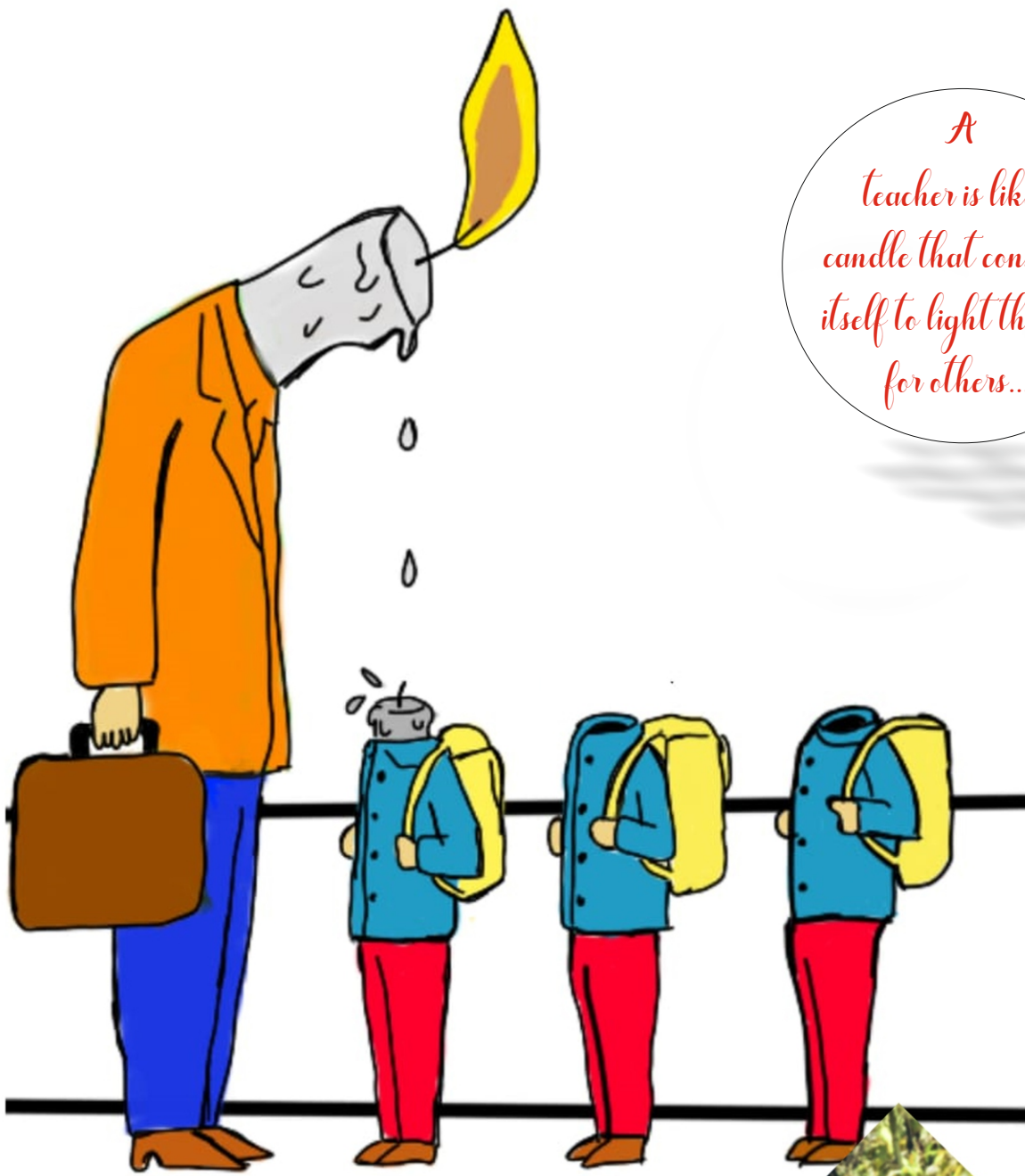


# FACTS 8

- 3) The first book he wrote was about the Philosophy of Rabindranath Tagore , which he believed to be the true manifestation of Indian spirit.
- 4) A very effective diplomat, he laid the foundation of India's relationship with Russia.
- 5) When he greeted Chairman Mao Zedong with a pat on the cheek.
- 6) Though his persona resembled that of a stern headmaster. he had a great sense humour too.
- 7) When his appointment as President of India was welcomed by Bertrand Russell
- 8) His name was nominated for the Nobel Prize in Literature for five consecutive years.

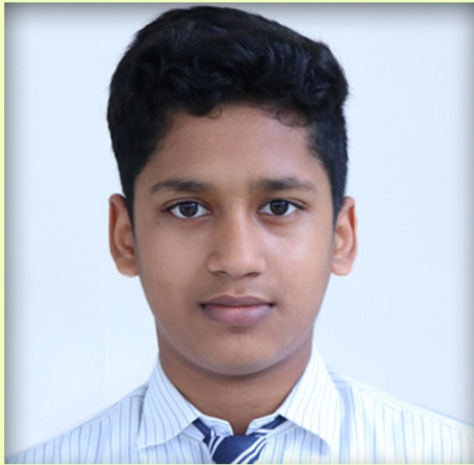
# Gift of God

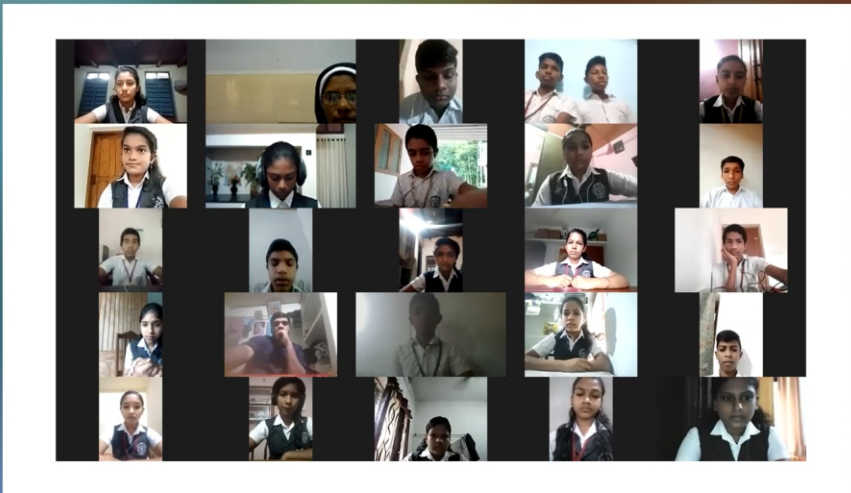
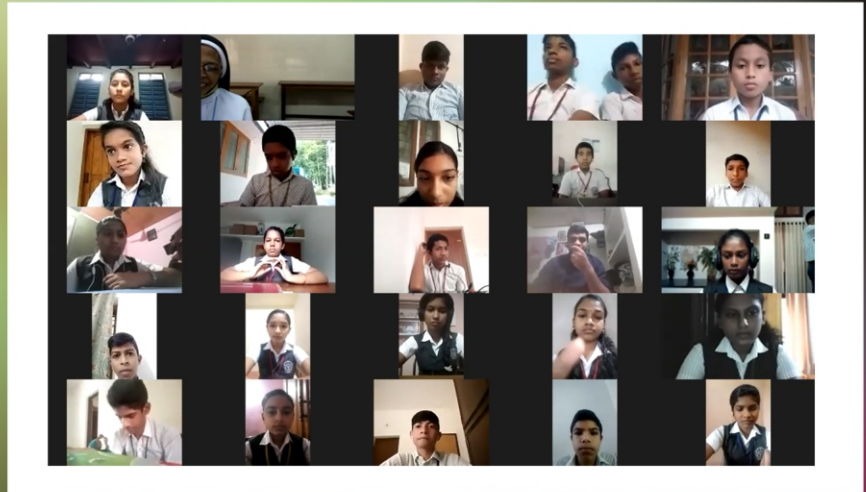
